Show Information

1. This show is officially sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association. Its rules shall govern. The Junior Doe and Senior Doe shows are separately sanctioned. Animals must be registered or recorded by ADGA, AGS or CGS.
2. Senior Does and Junior Does are sanctioned for Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Sable, Toggenburg and Recorded Grade.
3. Bucks are sanctioned for Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian and AOP.
4. Entry Fees will be \$5.00 per head per show. Pre-entries showing both days will be discounted to \$8.00 for both shows. Entries need to be postmarked by May 12, 2017. **Late entries are \$7.00 per head per show and will be assessed. Fees need to accompany entries.** In case of emergency, with 48 hour notice, fees may be returned.
5. Substitutions are allowed within the breed and sanction. (Jr. Alpine doe for Dry yearling Alpine doe). **MID-AMERICA highly encourages finished animals to show in the Champion-Challenge Class.**
6. Pen Fees. There will be a charge of \$6.00 per pen for the weekend. Pens **will not** be assigned. There will be plenty of pens, but **you will be charged for all you use.** Reserve what you need for your animals and tack. Pen size will hold 2 milkers. **MSF considers a chair or bale in an empty pen as used and will be billed to the club.**

7. The original registration certificate is required for all animals 6 months and over. Stamped duplicates for animals under 6 months of age are accepted. The date for computing age will be the day of check-in, May 26, 2017. These must be presented at time of check-in. No photocopies will be accepted.
8. No health papers are required by the club. Missouri requires out-of-state animals to have a health certificate. Animals showing evidence of an open or draining abscess, pinkeye, sore-mouth, ringworm, viral warts or scours not caused by stress will not be allowed in the barn. Decision of the show committee will be final.
9. Animals may arrive any time after 12:00pm on Friday, May 26, 2017. Animals must be in place by 6:00am the day they are to be shown.
10. All exhibitors are requested to wear white in the showing.
11. ***If you want to have bedding or feed (shavings, straw, brome or alfalfa) delivered you MUST make your arrangements with REA Farm & Bedding (660-287-6848 or 660-287-5623) before Thursday, May 25, at 5:00pm. They will at the barn Friday afternoon and Saturday morning. Shavings are \$7.00 per bale, straw is \$5.50, Brome \$7.50 and Alfalfa \$8.50. If you do not pre-order they will not have extra.***
12. Showmanship will be Saturday at 7:00am.
13. A one day official milk test will be offered. The cost is \$5.00 per goat. Milk out will be Friday, May 26th at 7:00pm. Second milking will be Saturday, 27th at 7:00am and the final milking at 7:00pm on Saturday. It will be necessary to have registration papers for each animal and all must have visible, correct tattoos. Jessica Krause and Laurie Gillis will be the official testers.
14. The Missouri State Fairgrounds are located on the SouthWest side of Sedalia. The swine pavilion is a large open-sided barn with shower facilities.
15. **The following are rules by the Missouri State Fair. No alcohol allowed. This will be enforced by local law enforcement. Campers will not be allowed to hook-up at the barn. Tents and covered cots are not allowed in the barn and aisles must be kept clear. No bicycles, skateboards or hover boards are allowed in the barn. They may be ridden outside the barn. Wagons cannot be used for play in the barn. No parking will be allowed on the east side of the barn. Vehicles and trailers must be moved immediately after unloading or loading.**
17. Lights out and quiet at Midnight, please
18. We request your dogs remain at home. If that is not possible, they must be kept in your pens or trailers.
19. A food vendor will be there Fri. evening, all day Sat. and until Sun. afternoon. The club will not be providing any meals. Coffee will be available.
20. **A Mid-America Dairy Goat Club meeting will be held in the show ring area Friday, May 26, 8:00pm for election of officers and other business.**
